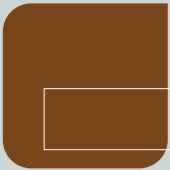

There is no limit to entries per person or media outlet unless otherwise indicated in the contest categories brochure. However, each single entry in any category MUST include its own entry forms in duplicate. One check for several entries will be acceptable. Fees MUST be paid at submission.

Entries submitted online do not need to have forms mailed. See SPJContest.com after December 31 for details.

All entries are to be submitted to Indiana Society of Professional Journalists, Attn: Rob Higley, Reveal Consulting. Make checks payable to INDIANA SOCIETY OF PROFESSIONAL JOURNALISTS. No cash, please.
